CODE OF CONDUCT ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

Fremont Youth League Board of Directors requires that all Commissioners, Coaches, Volunteers and players agree to comply with the below Code of Conduct. Please sign this form on the back and return to the League.

No manager, coach, player or spectator shall, at any time:

- Lay a hand upon, push, shove, strike, or threaten to strike an official or physical attack any board member, official, manager, coach, player or spectator.
- Verbal or physical abuse on any official for any real or imaginary belief of a wrong decision or judgment.
- An objectionable demonstration of dissent at an official's decision by throwing of gloves, helmets, hats, bats, balls, or any other unsportsmanlike-like action.
- The use of unnecessary rough tactics in the play of a game against the body of an opposing player.
- The use of profane, obscene or vulgar language in any manner at any time.
- Appear on the field of play, stands, or anywhere on the fields or complexes while in an intoxicated state.
 Intoxicated will be defined as an odor or behavior issue.
- Smoking while in the stands or on the playing field or in any dugout or non-designated areas.
- Discussing with spectators, spectators or the general public in a derogatory or abusive manner of any play or a opinion of any Board of Directors decision or against any Official/Commissioner/Coach/Player.
- The tampering or manipulating of any league rosters, schedules, tryouts, draft positions or selections, official score books, rankings, financial records or procedures.
- Challenge an Umpire's authority. The Umpires shall have the authority and discretion during a game to penalize the offender according to the infraction up to and including expulsion from the game.
- Disregard or intentionally violate League Rules and Regulations. All local playing rules, policies and procedures passed by the League must be followed, whether or not you agree with the rule.
- Engage in any activity, which gives rise to, or could give rise to, an appearance of claim of self-dealing, divided loyalty or conflict of interest by such person's position with League without prior notification to the Board of Directors.
- Be engaged in the usage of League equipment or uniforms for non-League teams, organizations, activities or for
 personal benefit. The League Board of Directors must approve in advance any special requests for use of League
 equipment or fields for non-League events in accordance to board policies.
- Expose Players, Coaches or Spectators to harm and unsafe conditions during practices, games or in transportation to and from locations for League activates.
- Coaches must follow League safety procedures during practices and games, including use of proper safety equipment for players.

The Board of Directors will review all infractions of the Zero Tolerance and Code of Conduct Policies. Depending on the seriousness or frequency, the Board of Directors may assess additional disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the league.
